- * Valid Certificate of Airworthiness
- * Weight and Balance
- * Proof of Insurance for the Aircraft
- * Valid Crew Licenses & Medical Certificate
- * A copy of the Intercept Orders (CFS) is highly recommended
- * Certificate of Registration
- * Journey Log
- * Pilot Operating Handbook for your aircraft.

Survival gear appropriate for geographic area, weather and climate conditions is also required. Minimum requirements include:

- * Means of starting a fire
- * Signalling device
- * Shelter (can be a blanket, tarp or means of building a shelter)
- * Water or a means of purifying water
- * First Aid Kit

As PIC, I will ensure that the required aircraft documents and survival gear are in the aircraft.

I understand that the South River-Sundridge Flying Club is not liable for any damage, injury or incident during the Air Rally.

Please join the South River-Sundridge Air Rally organized by the Flying Club!
This rally is open to all pilots and their passengers.

For those who have never participated in an Air Rally, it is not a race. It is recommended that each pilot have a copilot or passenger(s) with them for look out safety purposes.

Each pilot and passenger must be registered.

Before take-off, on each leg of the Rally route, an envelope with questions is given to each plane to be answered en route and handed in upon landing at the end of each leg. If only one person is on board, the envelope will be handed to that person upon shutdown of each leg and handed in 20 minutes later. The plane with the most correct answers/best score shall win the Rally. The Rally is carried out only during VFR with safety as a priority. It is always fun and the camaraderie is special. Guaranteed to meet many interesting people along the way.
